Aaron Kingsberry Director of Bands

Mr. Aaron Kingsberry received his Bachelor in Music Education from East Carolina University in 2012. That same summer, he took over as Director of Bands for North Pitt High School. Mr. Kingsberry was Director of Bands at North Pitt for sevens year from August 2012 until August 2018 where the program grew from seventeen students to one hundred twenty students. He is currently in his first year at Northside High School as Director of Bands. Mr. Kingsberry has very high hopes for his students at Northside and enjoys seeing the progress they have made thus far.

Under his direction at NPHS, North Pitt grew into four performing ensembles; a concert band, jazz band, percussion ensemble, and marching band. In September 2015 the Marching Band was a featured story on WNCT and was also used for commercials during the football season. The marching band have won many of 1st and 2nd place trophies in their three years existence. In the month of October 2015, Mr. Kingsberry was nominated for WITN's Teacher of the Week and also selected 2015-2016 North Pitt High School Teacher of the Year. Also in October 2015, Mr. Kingsberry was awarded the 2015-2016 Bright Ideas Award Winner by the Edgecombe-Martin County Electric Membership Corporation for his idea to purchase new music stands for the program. In August 2016, Mr. Kingsberry was a featured speaker at the Eastern District Band Director's Conference to speak about funding and growing a program financially. Also in November 2017 Mr. Kingsberry was a featured speaker at the North Carolina Music Educators Association Conference in Winston Salem, to speak about Cultural Diversity in the classroom. Under his direction, the program has spent over \$200,000 in upgrades and renovations in six years. In September 2017, Mr. Kingsberry started and is now the chapter advisor to the Tri M Music Honor Society Chapter 7442 with twenty four students being inducted.

Mr. Kingsberry's professional association's includes being a member of the North Carolina Music Educators Association, North Carolina Bandmasters Association, the Percussive Arts Society, and an Honorary Brother of Kappa Kappa Psi Fraternity Incorporated. Socially he is a brother of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity Inc. He also is currently the Drumline Instructor for the East Carolina University Marching Pirates Drumline.
